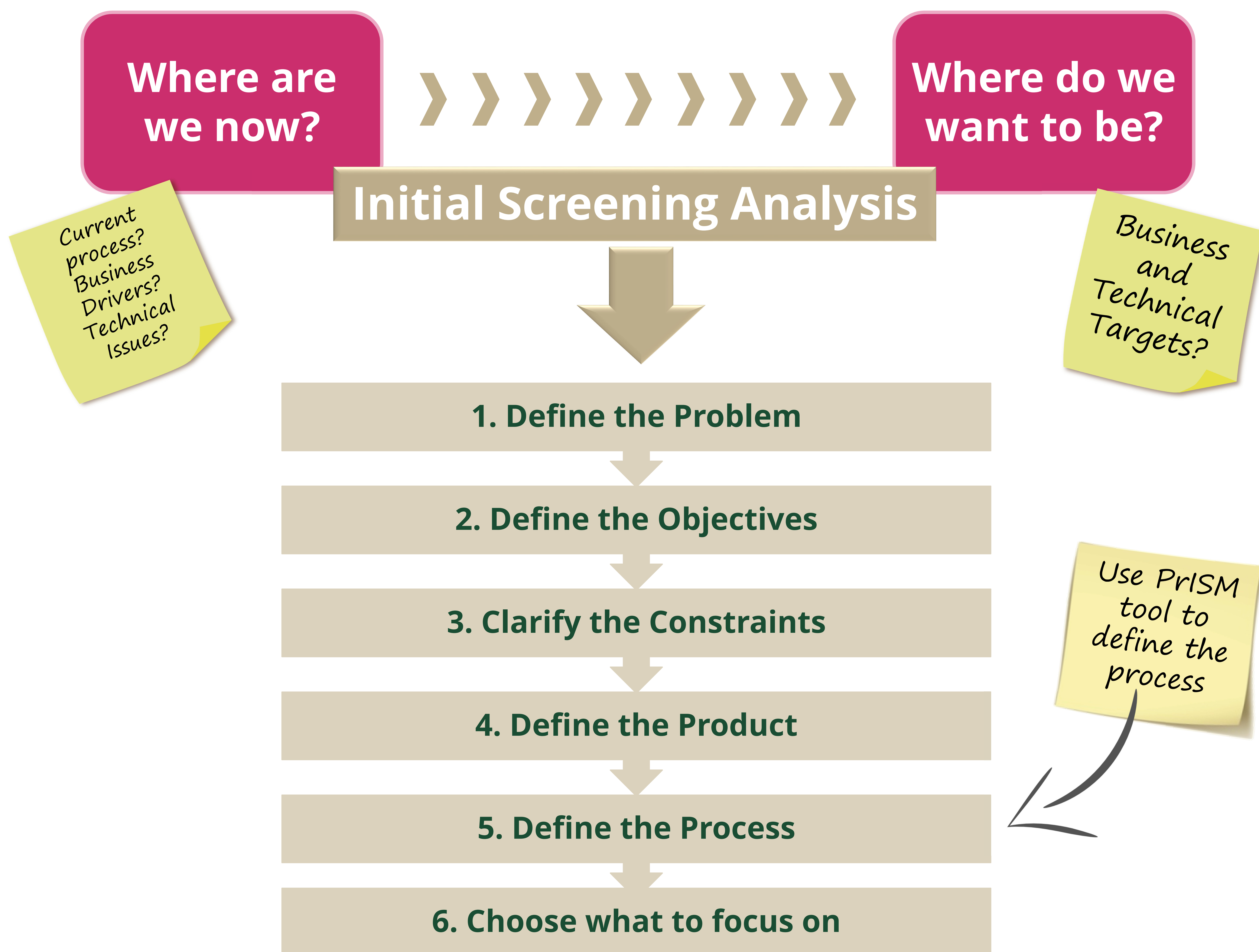




Initial Screening Analysis

Bristest's **Initial Screening Analysis** (ISA) is a high level 'scene setting' methodology that is used at the beginning of a Bristest study to:

- Outline the background to the problem being investigated
- Gain a consensus view on the business / technical objectives for the study
- Identify any real and perceived constraints to solutions generated
- Capture key information on feeds, products, wastes and conditions



The ISA methodology brings together business and technical information - and benefits from input from both functions. It provides a common understanding of the problem and an agreed approach to the rest of the study.
