




# Process Information Summary Map

Britest's **Process Information Summary Map (PrISM)** tool provides a high level overview of the sequence of stages in a process, summarising inputs and output, and recording key information e.g. quantity, cost and specification.


The PrISM tool is used during an Initial Screening Analysis to provide a visual means of capturing key information about each stage of a process and help to identify where to 'chase value'. It is best used with multi-stage processes (Process Definition Diagrams can be more productive for single stage processes).



## Example PrISM for the process of making coffee

The information presented in the PrISM should be adjusted to suit the specific process and the aims of the study.

For troubleshooting there would be less information about costs and more about quality control tests and process reproducibility.
